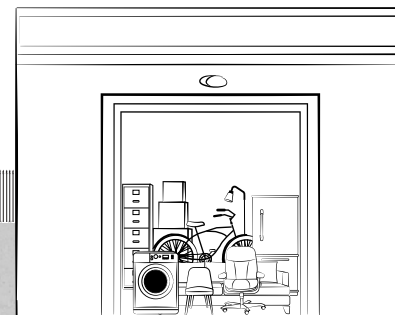


What Can and Can't be Stored in a Storage Unit?



When looking to reserve a storage unit, our customers often have a few questions about what types of items are permitted or prohibited to store. Here's a quick guide to help answer those questions:

Permitted Storage Unit Items

✓ Seasonal Items

- Boxes of winter or summer clothes
- Sporting equipment (e.g. fishing rods, skis, snowshoes, or surfboards)
- Camping gear
- Holiday decorations
- Equipment, such as leaf and snow blowers or lawnmowers (drained of all fuel)

✓ Household goods

- Books
- Furniture
- Toys
- Clothes
- Linens
- Kitchen items
- Office supplies

✓ Commercial goods

- Office furniture
- Supplies
- Equipment
- Office decor
- Product and service supplies (non-hazardous only)
- Shipping and packaging supplies
- Files of paperwork, documents, and records

✓ Electronics

Dust covers recommended

- TVs
- DVD or Blu Ray players
- Gaming systems
- Digital devices
- Stereo systems
- Computer equipment (monitors and printers)

✓ Appliances (Cleaned)

- Refrigerators
- Stoves
- Microwaves
- Washers
- Dryers
- Freezers
- Smaller appliances (toasters, coffee makers, vacuums, and paper shredders)

Prohibited Storage Unit Items

✗ Hazardous Materials

- Anything that can catch fire or explode, such as:
 - Gasoline
 - Propane
 - Oil
 - Grease
 - Chemicals
 - Cleaners
 - Fireworks
- Paint
- Illegal substances
- Radioactive materials
- Anything toxic or hazardous (e.g. biological waste, fertilizer, asbestos)
- Anything with a noxious smell (at the Operator's sole judgement)

✗ Unregistered Vehicles

All vehicles must be fully registered, insured, and in operable condition. This includes:

- Boats
- RVs
- Trailers
- Motorcycles
- Cars
- Trucks

✗ Weapons

- Firearms
- Ammunition
- Explosives

✗ Perishables

- Produce
- Meats
- Dairy
- Cereals
- Rice
- Animal products (e.g. pet food)

✗ Living Things

- People
- Animals
- Plants/Seeds
